DEFINITION:

DPR's Roving Leaders are responsible for developing and implementing broad-based programs, activities and intervention for youth. Recreation programming, counseling and rapport building are tools used to engage the youth in positive leisure service activities. The programs include the; Camp Footloose, Talented ladies in the Community, Youth Motivation, Community Outreach, Fun Wagon, Skate Mobile, Obstacle Course, Rock Wall, and Movie Night Out.

EXAMPLE OF DUTIES:

- Plan and implement daily camp programs and activities for Roving Leader camps/programs
- Assist with the outreach services in at risk communities
- Crisis Intervention and Resolutions.
- Conduct youth development engagement
- Engage youth of all ages in positive recreational activities.
 - Interact with youth via mobile recreation
 - Assist and Teach youth to use recreation equipment.
 - Maintain care and upkeep of the equipment and supplies.
- Assist with gang intervention services, counseling and social-service referrals.
- Provide support to citywide special events and initiatives.
- Escort youth on field trips throughout the city
- Develop violence prevention programs

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS/EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE:

- Must be 21 years of age or older
- Possess at least 2 years of experience working with the target population youth and young adults
- Experience in organizing, planning and implementing mobile recreation activities.
- Able to manage and lead groups of aggressive youth.
- Able to work outdoors, in heat and all-weather conditions
- Able to do lifting of heavy equipment

EXAMPLE OF DUTIES:

- The incumbent operates the assigned vehicle to provide a variety of transportation services.
- Operates the Fun Wagon, Skate Mobile, Movie Night Out and Rock Wall vehicles transporting the seasonal staff and equipment to the assigned communities
- Transport youth and seasonal staff on Field trips and to special events throughout the city.
- Monitor and report on the status/needs and upkeep of the vehicle used.
- Loads and unloads the supplies and equipment
- Assist with the outreach services
- Engage youth of all ages in positive recreation activities
- Interact with youth at all time
- Teaching youth to use recreation equipment (bikes, scooter, jump rope etc.;
