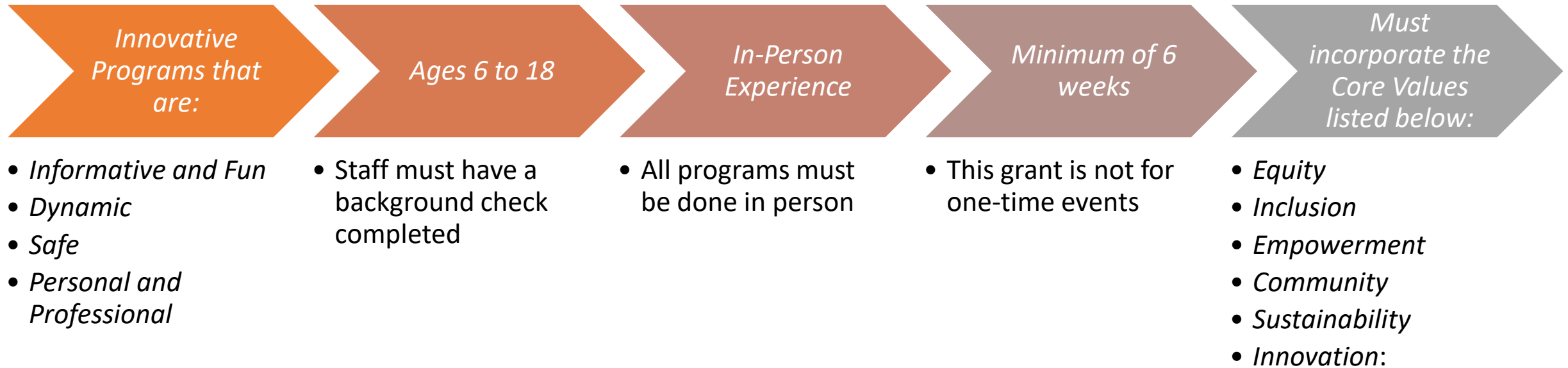

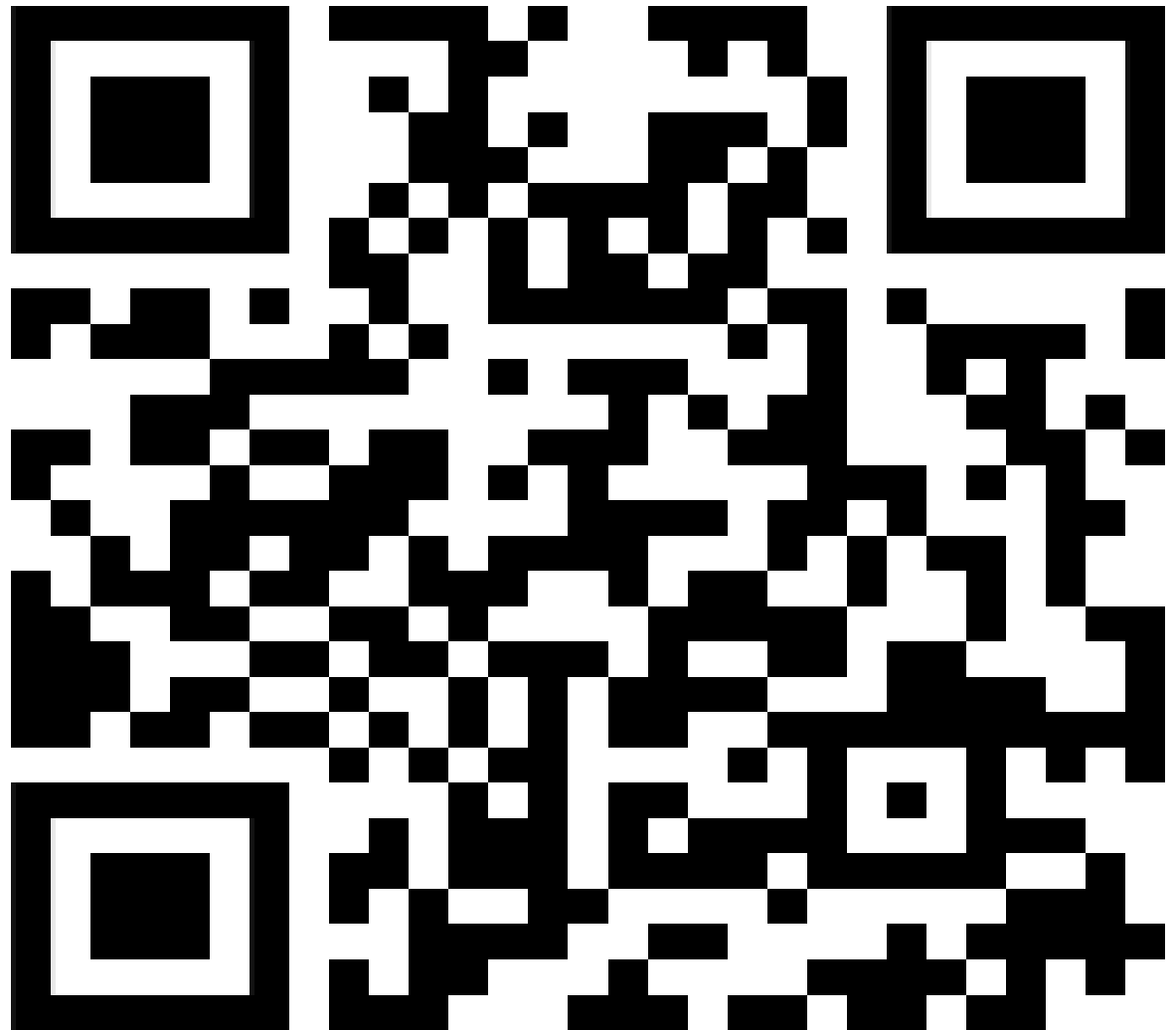

Organizations can request up to \$100,000 to support the launch or expansion of a new or existing program.

# Programming Grant

## Payments and Invoicing:

- Awardee will receive a Purchase Order from the DIFS System
- All invoices will be submitted in DIFS
- There are two payments
  - Payment one is outlined in the RFA
  - Payment two will be outline in NOGA based on the application submitted

PLEASE make sure organization is registered for DIFS.

# SEE (Support, Engagement and Event & Travel) Grant

## Support

Five thousand dollars (\$5,000) grant to purchase equipment, supplies, and materials for existing programs including sports, cultural arts, and youth development.

## Engagement

Ten thousand dollars \$10,000 grant for field trips and other engagement activities for youth groups.

## Event and Travel

Ten thousand dollars \$10,000 grant to support either an event, tournament, or travel for athletic competitions for youth groups.
