DPR Garden Tool Share Program

DC Parks and Recreation (DPR) is happy to announce its Garden Tool Share Program for the Spring of 2015. This program will assist District gardeners who need help temporarily attaining garden tools for one-time use or events by allowing them to borrow a variety of garden tools for one week increments. This program will be managed in DPR's online registration system called ASAP. Participants must register in ASAP to be part of the program. Once registered, participants will coordinate with the DPR Community Garden Specialist for tool pickups, returns and any safety demonstrations. Costs Registration in the program will require the registrant to agree to pay for damage or loss of tools, waive liability, and assume the risk of use. Any damage of use beyond normal wear and tear (which will be assessed by the DPR community Garden Specialist) and replacement fees if tools are late or lost or unreturned shall be charged to the program participant for payment within 10 days: Fees are as follows: Late Fees One dollar a day late fee until the tool is returned or the item reaches its estimated value. Cleaning Fees All tools must be cleaned before drop off. Failure to clean a tool will result in a \$5 cleaning fee. Damage fees If a tool is damaged beyond normal wear and tear (which will be assessed by the DPR Community Garden Specialist), participants will be charged an estimated fee to repair or replace a tool. Missing Fees If tools are lost or not returned a replacement fee will be incurred at the estimated price of the tool Failure to pay fees within ten days will result in immediate removal of the program and possible civil fines pursuant to D.C. Official Code 10-137.01 (e). Tools A full list of tools can be viewed on the DPR Community Garden Program page. Please check with the DPR Community Garden Specialist for availability. If there are any tools needed but not on the list please email a tool request to the DPR Community Garden Specialist. Tool Participant Requirements All participants must: Be 18 or older Have a valid driver license or ID card Have a valid credit card Be a current DC resident and verify residency Assume all risk in using DPR tools Agree to pay for damage or loss of tools and cleaning and late fees within 10 days of a fee being issued Tool Exchange Times Tools can be picked up and dropped off during two time periods a week. Monday 9-10am Friday 4-5pm Pickups and drop-offs must be arranged prior with the DPR Community Garden Specialist and all drop-offs must be made in person. Any tools not physically handed to the DPR Community Garden Specialist to be returned may result in a missing tool fee. All initial assessments of the tool must be made during the drop off. Exceptions to drop off times may be made for extreme weather conditions or other major events which would prevent reasonable travel through the District. Tool Check Out Lengths Participants can check a tool out for one week at a time. The tool must be returned within the week. Failure to return tools on time will result in a \$1 a day late fee. Charges will continue to accrue until the tool is returned or reaches its approximate value. There are no automatic renewals for any tools. Participants can only check out a tool for another concurrent week if there are no other participants waiting for that tool. Tool Check Out Limits Only one power tool may be checked out at a time unless the DPR Community Garden Specialist has given explicit permission. Only 5 hand tools may be checked out at a time unless the DPR Community Garden Specialist has given explicit permission. Liability All participants must sign a waiver of liability form before borrowing any tool. Only the borrower registered on ASAP may use the checked out tool. All participants must participate in a short and specific tool safety lesson taught by the DPR Community Garden Specialist before checking out any tool.

EcoCity Farms Demonstration Tour and Vermicompost / Bokashi Class

The first part of this class will be a tour of ECO City Farms' Edmonston Urban Farm. On this sub-acre plot, we will experience space-saving techniques, season-extension technologies, various compost systems, and other methods for utilizing the space intensively to serve the Farm's 20+ member year-round CSA and farmers' market. The second part of this class will be on the most appropriate form of composting in urban environments: Bokashi and Vermicomposting. Bokashi is container-composting, using fermentation to prepare our compostables for the second stage of the process: composting with worms (vermicomposting). Although not necessary once Bokashi is ready, Vermicomposting enhances to Bokashi compost to provide some of the richest compost in the world: worm castings. And it can all be done without fear of vermin, odors, heavy labor, and space! Teacher Bio: Christian spent the last few years as Farm Manager at ECO City Farms, a few miles outside DC in Prince George's County, MD. On this 1-acre urban farm (or ""big garden""), the farm used organic methods, compost, and season extension tools to provide fresh vegetables, fruits, and sprouts to our 25-person CSA and farmers market. More importantly, as a non-profit educational organization, is the mission to help urban communities use agriculture to positively develop their communities.

Intro to Urban Aquaponics

Aquaponics is a method of raising fish and plants together. This closed loop system provides many advantages compared to conventional food growth. Aquaponics uses 1/10 of the water needed in conventional food growing techniques and is also significantly less labor intensive. The system comprises of a fish tank and grow beds for the plants and a pump to circulate the water from the tank to the beds. The fish provide the nutrients for the plants and the plants clean the water for the fish.
