DPR Urban Beekeeping Program Application

The DC Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR) supports urban beekeeping in an effort to increase the bee population in the District. At present, the agency has seven designated beehive sites with the capacity to safely and responsibly host beehives.

In order to ensure the safety of each hive and to ensure the proper management of hives, each designated beehive site is managed by DPR partner and non-profit organization, DC Beekeeper Alliance. The DC Beekeeper Alliance is comprised of leading urban beekeeping experts dedicated to ensuring DC beekeepers have the necessary education, mentorship, assistance, and support to safely and responsibility care for beehives.
